We were facing increased costs in 2023 and weren't certain where the new income would come from and yet we've kept ahead of the finances and stayed in the black for the year. And we are poised to end the year strong. Rentals of our rooms are up, food service has been excellent, notably the Tuesday night dinners and Sunday breakfasts have been successful. And the Trolls" Den has seen increased income. All income sources, including donations, help keep us paying the bills and funding the Building Association in order that the building is maintained, and we are insured, so we can run the business of the lodge. We follow the mission of keeping the culture and heritage alive, all the while enjoying each other's company while we work together to enjoy our place. Like it was meant to be! I just addressed the Leikarringen youth dance group at their parent meeting last week. The Marine Room was full of parents and grandparents and families listening to the volunteer staff of teachers orient them for the year and schedule of events and practices. This program provides a big spark for our lodge and community as they learn Scandinavian style dance and perform at various functions, parades, schools and retirement facilities. Did You Know that on September 2, 1964, the President of the United States signed Proclamation 3610 calling for October 9th to be celebrated as Leif Erikson Day. Leif Erikson, Norse explorer and great seafarer, also called Erik the Lucky, was the son of Erik the Red, who had settled in Greenland after being banned from Iceland. Leif Erikson is considered the first European to step foot on the shores of continental North America in the year 1000.


